Make lists of items made from: plastic, wood, metal, glass and fabric.	Draw a picture of your best friend. Write why they are a good friend to you.	Write out the alphabet and sing the alphabet song.
Go on a nature walk and collect signs of Autumn e.g. conkers or take photos.	Watch 2D and 3D shape songs on YouTube	Read lots of fairy stories and traditional tales. Can you retell the story?	Write about special days out, hobbies and favourite activities.	Print out a photo of you as a baby and bring it to show the class. How have you changed?
Draw Guy Fawkes and explain what you know about him.	Practise reading, writing and spelling your Year 1 words.	Look at a map of the U.K. Can you find where you live? Can you find England, Ireland, Scotland, and Wales?	Go on a 3D shape hunt. Find objects that are: spheres, cubes, cuboids, cones, pyramids and cylinders.	Make a Sunflower out of plasticine.
Count from 1 to 100. Can you say the numbers backwards?	Write a letter to Father Christmas!	Count and get fit with Jack Hartmann on Youtube. Count in 2s, 5s and 10s.	Interview your grandparents. Find out what their childhood was like.	Write some sums and find the answer e.g. $13 + 4 =$ $20 - 5 =$
Make a Christmas shoebox for Operation Christmas Child.	Draw a funny self-portrait. Use lots of bright colours.	Draw a picture to show everyone in your family.
