









Autumn 2017 Home-Learning

Investigate the discovery of electricity or how it is produced.</p> 	<p>Create your own home learning task.</p> 	<p>Design and make a maths game to learn time facts, telling the time using an analogue and digital clock. Write the title of your game and an explanation of how to play.</p>
<p>Visit a park or wood. What wildlife can you spot? Choose one to research and create own fact file.</p> 	<p>Explore signs of Autumn. Perhaps take some photos of the changes. Write a poem using your senses to describe the changes.</p> 	<p>Research the planes that were used in World War 2.</p> 
<p>Create a presentation or poster to show the things you would like to achieve. They might be school related or linked to things you do in your own time.</p>	<p>Investigate war time recipes. Choose one that appeals and have a go at cooking it. What does it taste like?</p> 	<p>Research Air raid shelters. Make a model of one. As an extension write about your chosen type of shelter.</p>
