Investigate the facilities that Lacey has: the types of shops, facilities. How can you show this data?



Make a model of Stonehenge. Try to use different/unusual materials to make it.



Describe your 'super beast'. How does he move? What does he eat? What is special about him? How would you care for him?



Design a shield/piece of jewellery that could be made from iron/bronze. Think about how you would decorate it to make it special.



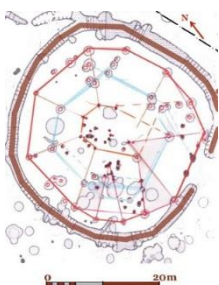
Imagine you are a Stone Age man visiting the modern day. Write a diary entry about what you have seen & done.
