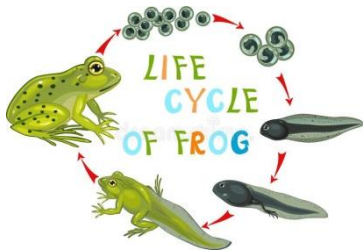


Year 2 Home-Learning

Describe different animals and explain their life cycles.



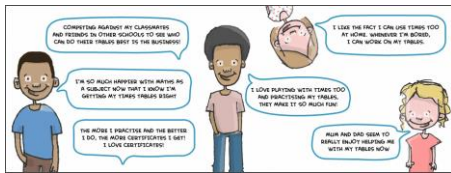
Compare seaside holidays in the past to your family holiday.



Create a poster to persuade people to send their children to Stanford. Make sure that you include all of the reasons why you enjoy Stanford.



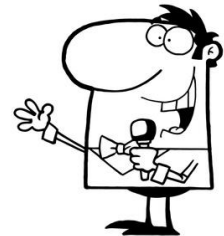
Create different ways to learn times tables. Do you know your 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables?
