that we look forward to sharing with you.

Topic

Our **History** topic is to find out about how life has changed in Britain since 1948.

We would like to find out the answers to the following questions:

Can I identify some of the main changes in Britain since 1948 and identify key characteristics of different decades?

Can I find out some of the main events of the 1950s, 60s, 70s and 80s and investigate what life was like during this period?

Can I investigate what life was like in Britain in the 1990s and identify connections between different aspects of life since 1948?

Our **Geography** topic is locating countries across the world,
with a focus on North America.

We would like to find out the answers to the following questions:

Can I locate the continent of North America on a world map?

Can I identify some different climate zones in North America?

Can I identify and describe some geographical features of North America?

Our **Hook Day** for this topic will be on **Friday 26th April** - children can dress up in outfits from the 1950s, 1960s, 1970s or 1980s!
