MATHS

Symmetrical art and rotational symmetry.

Ratio when mixing paints. For example, to make purple, you mix 3 parts red to 7 parts blue.

Perspective, tessellations, 2D and 3D shapes and repeating patterns.

Enterprise projects- calculating simple costs and profit made.

Measuring with rulers.

SEN

To overcome potential barriers to learning in Art and Design, some pupils may need:

- help in managing the art equipment
- a multisensory approach
- access to adapted resources to overcome difficulties with mobility or manipulative skills.
- Awareness of allergies

LITERACY

- Read about artists and their work
Read, retrieve and remember facts
- Use artistic vocabulary
- Write plans and instructions
- Communicate feelings and emotions about specific artworks
- Talk about ideas with others when planning and creating artworks
- Share personal responses about artworks and positive arts experiences discussing preferences and defending points of view when reviewing artworks
- Evaluating own art work
