

### Communication and Language

Listen to stories, poems & read non-fiction books associated with Christmas.

Listen to environmental sounds linked to Christmas e.g. sleigh bells, Carol singers...

Tell stories about Christmas or festivals.

Retell the Nativity Story using puppets, role play, story cards

Christmas performance learning songs, acting and telling story to parents.

Answer problems solving questions e.g. How will we get our letters to Santa? How can we organise a Christmas party?

### Expressive Arts and Design

Make Christmas cards, presents for family

Make large scale Christmas pictures adding collage media to decorate e.g. glitter.

Accompany Christmas songs with percussion instruments generating rhythms and sound patterns.

Learn Nativity songs and perform to others.

Use different media to create wrapping paper.

Create Christmas decoration.

Develop thematic role play area e.g. stable for nativity or theatre and encourage music, songs, dances etc...

### PD

**Gymnastics** – Use of Space

**Games** – Basic Motor skills

**Fine motor** –Pencil control, scissor control practise cutting cards, Dough Disco, sewing

**Gross motor** – Paint stars outside with large brushes, water and glitter

### Literacy

Learn phonics sounds

Blend sounds for reading and segment sounds to spell CVC words

Play initial sound matching games with letters and objects

Use role-play as a focus for writing invitation to Christmas party, letter to Santa.

Write Christmas wish lists, cards, letters to Santa

Read poems, stories and songs linked to Christmas

Use websites to search for celebration images

Use cameras, iPods to take pictures of Christmas, Nativity, celebrations/party

### Understanding the World

Share and recall memories of Christmas from previous years.

Talk about seasonal changes.

Find out about Christmas in the past.

How do we celebrate Christmas using stories, pictures, greetings cards, and info from websites.

Look at festive artefacts e.g. crib, stain glass windows, advent calendars and candles

Use online resources to read the Nativity story.

Use simple paint programs to design Christmas tree or wrapping paper

Look closely at pine cones, Christmas branches

### Maths

Use Christmas themed objects to count e.g. points on a star, trees, baubles, stockings, presents etc.

Numbered star hunt e.g. Find stars and then ordering them smallest to the largest number.

Christmas decoration role play shop, selling decorations and begin to recognise coins used in the shop.

Make starry pictures and count the total number of stars and find the matching numerals.

Paint numerals 1-10 on stars, trees or stockings and use them to order sequentially or order them by size.

Role play Christmas shop to develop vocabulary linked to calculations.

Use dough to cut stars. Use stars for problem solving activities involving addition and subtraction.

Use 2D and 3D shapes to make Santa's presents.
