


English Can I understand both the books I can already read accurately and fluently and those I listen to by discussing the significance of the title and events? Can I ask and answer questions?

Can I write stories by sequencing sentences to form short narratives? Can I punctuate sentences and develop writing with interesting adjectives and vocabulary?

Read exciting adventure stories 'Claude in the City', 'Paddington Bear and 'Beegu'. Discuss the character's feelings and dilemmas in different environments. (P4C)

Develop **higher order questioning**. Non-fiction writing about the city.

Write about real life events; holiday news, diary entries, recounts of school events and trips- cross curricular writing opportunities. **World Book Day 7th March.**



History Changes within living memory. Can I learn about the history of toys? Explore a timeline of the history of toys.

Compare toys 'then' and 'now'. Create a class toy museum. Find out about the toys our parents and grandparents played with.

Music Can I listen and appraise different musical styles? Can I learn new songs and sing expressively with others?

Learn the Paddington song. Listen to Peruvian music: pan pipes. Charanga: In the Groove and Rhythm in the Way We Walk and Banana Rap. Play simple parts on instruments, including glockenspiels.

Design & Technology Can I design, make and evaluate? Can I learn about Peruvian weaving and weave my own pattern?

Cooking and Nutrition: Can I design and make a healthier sandwich for Paddington?

Computing Can I log into Purple Mash independently and become familiar with a range of programs and tools? Unit 1.5 Maze Explorers (2Go) directional games and Unit 1.6 Animated Story Books (2Create a Story).

Maths Can I count, read and write numbers 1-50? Can I find 1 more and 1 less? Can I explore number patterns and count in multiples of twos, fives and tens?

Can I add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero? Calculate the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and solve abstract problems (number sentences)

Can I measure objects and record heights and lengths?

Can I begin to learn about mass, weight, capacity and volume? Compare, describe and solve practical problems for mass/weight: (heavy/light, heavier than, lighter than); capacity and volume (full/empty, more than, less than, half, half full, quarter).

Seasonal Change: Can I observe seasonal changes and discuss how day length varies and the weather associated with each season?

Outdoor learning: Explore the changes from: Winter to Spring.

Working Scientifically: Use observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions.



SMSC Going for Goals: Can I set goals and make a New Year's Resolution? Can I take turns to speak, listen to others' suggestions and talk about what I am going to do?

Changes: Can I discuss different kinds of changes that happen in life? Exploring feelings and ways to cope with changes.

Geography Can I name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans? Can I compare similarities and differences between the U.K. and Peru? Use Geographical vocabulary to compare London with Lima. Discuss weather, climate and landscapes. Explore famous buildings and landmarks.

PE Gymnastics: Can I develop control, co-ordination and balance on the apparatus?
