Fieldtrip to Cleethorpes on Monday 20th March

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our commitment to providing an enriching and exciting curriculum, we are delighted to inform you that we have arranged for Year 3 pupils to take part in a fieldtrip to the Cleethorpes' coastline.

This will be an opportunity for children to explore their local area looking at the geographical features of the coast and consolidate their scientific studies of rocks, coastal creatures and their habitats. If the weather permits it, we intend to sketch the wildlife and features of the coast. As a part of the seaside experience, we have also arranged for children to have a lunch of chips and an ice cream. School lunches will be cancelled on this day.

In order to finance the visit, we would be grateful for a voluntary contribution of **£10.00**. If the provision of a voluntary contribution is a cause for concern, then please get in touch and you can discuss the matter in confidence with the school business manager Dawn King. Please note if school receives insufficient funds to pay for this trip then it may have to be cancelled.

We will set off and return within normal school hours. It is quite brisk walking along the coast; we would therefore ask that the children are dressed warmly with hats and gloves and in clothes suitable for beach exploration. We will be investigating the marshlands and beach pools so wellington boots would be advisable as well as a change of shoes for walking, preferably in a small rucksack for them to carry their things and their water bottles.
