Inter-faith Celebrations – Spring 2025

During this season we recognise, as a school, that there are many events taking place around the world that are observed and celebrated by a range of faiths. As part of our vision, this year we would like to ensure that pupils have opportunities to learn about a variety of faith celebrations.

These are our plans:

Easter Service and Craft

Children in **Foundation Stage and Key Stage One** will be visited by the vicar for an Easter service on **Tuesday 1st April**. As a slight change this year, pupils will make Easter hats (foundation) and cards (Year 1 & 2) in class this year, to bring home at the end of term.



Eid Food Workshop

Year 3 and Year 4 will take part in a food workshop with our catering providers, where they will learn how to make some cuisine that is typically eaten at Eid celebrations. This will take place in classes on **Thursday 27th March**.

Holi Colour Run

Year 5 and Year 6 will consolidate their learning about the Hindu festival of Holi – which celebrates the arrival of Spring, love and new life – by taking part in a colour run on the school field. This will involve running a course while having paint thrown at them. Sunglasses/eye protection will be provided! Pupils will be reminded to wear something they don't mind getting messy on this day! This will take place on **Friday 4th April**.
