Parents/carers are expected to socially distance themselves at the gate when collecting. Only 1 parent to drop off and collect child/ren. Please wear a mask when collecting and dropping off your child/ren. Always be courteous to others, this is not a normal situation and can be distressing for some, please be respectful of others. Thank you for your co-operation.

Please drop off your child at the designated gate assigned to your child's Class.

Be aware of your start time and finish time, don't be late or too early! This will affect the safety of others. If you are delayed at drop off please keep your distance whilst waiting at the gates.



Keep a 2m distance from anyone you don't live with.

However tempting it might be to have a catch up with others at the school gate, please don't!
We need your help and cooperation to ensure the smooth running of this fine table. Keeping everyone safe on their journey to and from school is everyone's responsibility.

Living together - Learning together

As before, if you are able, we ask that adults wear face coverings and only one adult accompanies your child at a time. To reduce the risk of transmission, please only bring essential items to school. This includes a coat, gloves and hats if needed, book bag, lunch box if needed, PE Kit and a named water bottle. We expect pupils to wear their school uniform but please contact us if there are any issues with this request.

School lunches will be provided to those who wish to order them via the online meals selector system. To receive a school lunch for the week commencing Monday 8th March, orders must be placed by Sunday 28th February.

The breakfast and afterschool club will be available but there will be reduced availability so please ensure you book and reserve your place 48hrs in advance on www.SCOpay.com.
