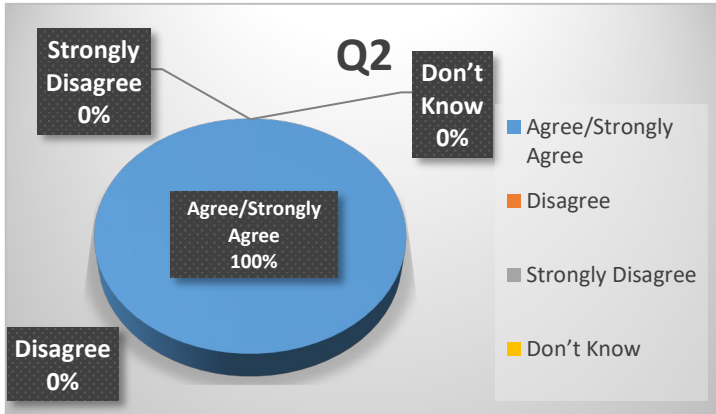


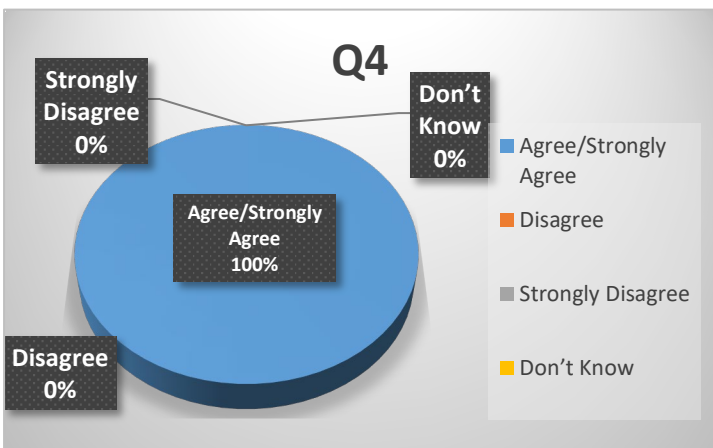

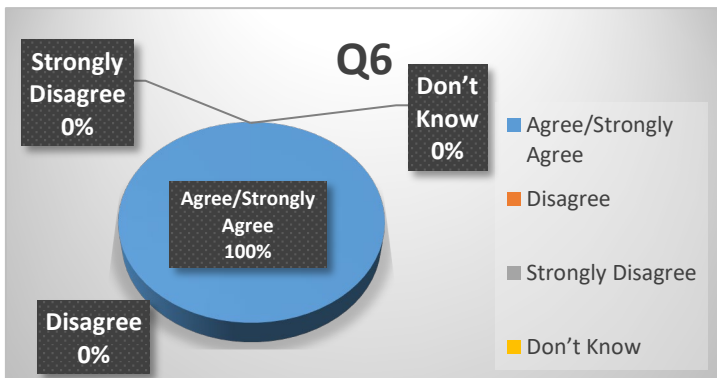
1) My child is happy at school



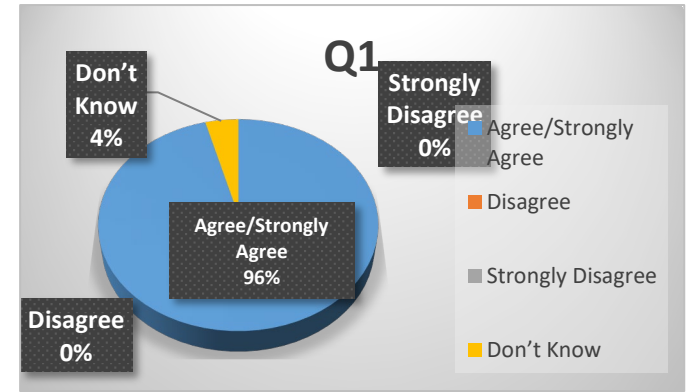
3) The school supports my child's wider personal development



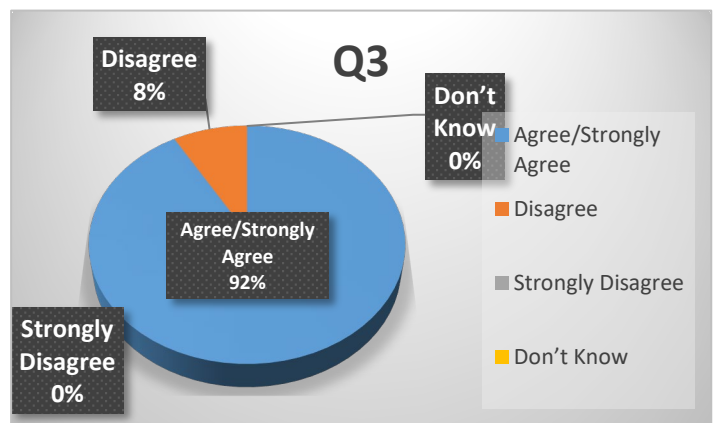
5) My child receives the right amount of homework



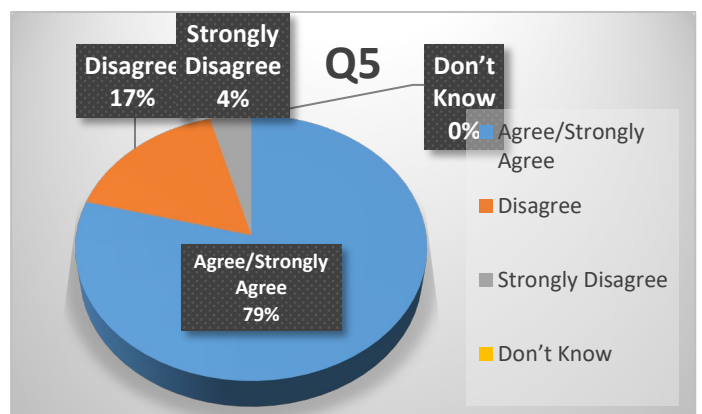
7) My child knows who to speak to if they are upset or unhappy at school



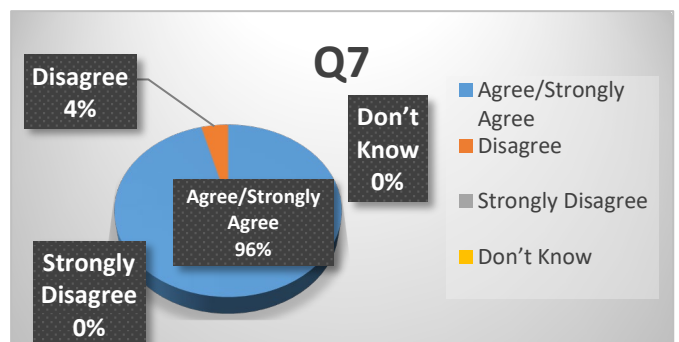
2) My child experiences a wide variety of learning opportunities

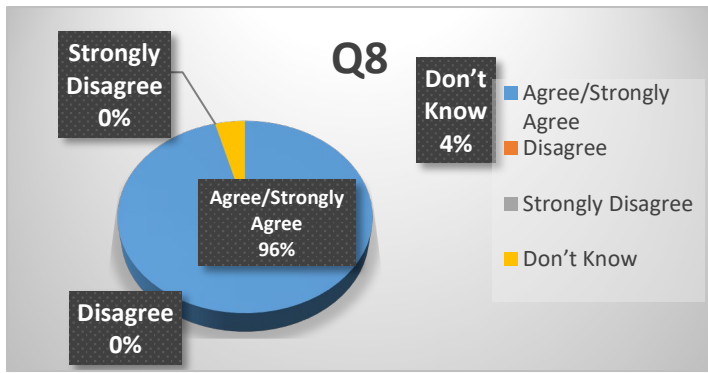
