Please ensure your child brings a packed lunch in a disposable bag, together with a non-fizzy drink. If your child normally has a school meal don't forget to go online and cancel it <u>before Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> March</u>.

We will set off and return within normal school hours. Children can wear their own clothes, including appropriate outdoor shoes and waterproof coats if possible, as much of the day will be spent outdoors.

Children can bring additional money to spend at the gift shop, no more than £5. This will need to be in a named envelope and handed to the class teacher.
