

Dear Parents/Carers

**Re: Year 5/6 Activity Day Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2026**

After our previous very successful Activity Days, we are excited to be able to continue with this event this year to celebrate the end of the term and help raise School funds.

The current Year 5 and 6 pupils will be working collaboratively to design and organise a fun activity day for all Children, that will take place throughout the school day on Wednesday 1st July. They will have to consider making their activity appealing, to others to ensure their activity is successful, and use their enterprise skills to organise, design and advertise their activity working as a team throughout. The children are very excited to be running this event. A range of activities, games and stalls will be on offer.

Most of the stalls will cost 50p to take part in; a few select stalls will cost £1. We will be using a token system which can be purchased via the Arbor system at a price of £1 for two tokens. All payments will need to be made in advance before Monday 29th June, this is essential as admin time will be required to provide children with stamp cards, which they will carry instead of cash. Please note that payments can only be made in increments of £1 and will be capped at £5 per pupil. This would mean children can visit a maximum of 10 stalls. There will also be some free activities for pupils to take part in during the day!

We will be having a non-uniform day on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June and we would be grateful if you would donate sweets to support this event for the children to use as prizes for the stalls. To observe hygiene, allergy and dietary requirements we ask that the sweets be individually wrapped or treat size bags, specifically Starbursts, Swizzle sweets or Haribo as detailed below. As always we appreciate your continued support, we look forward to having a fun-packed and exciting activity day to raise funds for our school.

### Starburst:

Ingredients. SUGAR, CORN SYRUP, HYDROGENATED PALM KERNEL OIL; LESS THAN 2% OF: CITRIC ACID, TAPIOCA DEXTRIN, GELATIN, APPLE JUICE FROM CONCENTRATE, MODIFIED CORN STARCH, NATURAL AND ARTIFICIAL FLAVORS, COLOURS (RED 40, YELLOW 5, YELLOW 6, BLUE 1).

### Haribo:

Ingredients: Glucose Syrup (derived from wheat or corn), sugar, dextrose, gelatine (primarily pork-derived, though some regions offer beef-gelatine or vegan alternatives) some bags are vegan and gelatine free, fruit Juice from Concentrate (apple, strawberry, lemon, raspberry, orange, pineapple), citric Acid (used for flavour and preservation), fruit and Plant Concentrates (for natural colouring from sources like spirulina, elderberry, blackcurrant, and apple), flavourings, glazing Agents (beeswax, carnauba wax), Sunflower Oil

### Swizzels:

Sweets generally contain sugar, glucose syrup, acidity regulators (like malic and citric acid), vegetable oils, and anti-caking agents. Depending on the exact candy, they also feature flavourings and natural colours. Most Swizzels products are free from gluten, nuts, dairy, and eggs.

Specific ingredients vary by treat:

- **Love Hearts & Fizzers:** Sugar, malic acid, stearic acid, sodium bicarbonate, modified starch, magnesium stearate, anti-caking agent (magnesium carbonate), flavourings, and natural colours.
  - **Double Lollies:** Sugar, stearic acid, modified starch, acidity regulator (malic acid), magnesium stearate, magnesium carbonate, flavourings, and colours.
- Drumstick & Squashies:** Glucose syrup, sugar, vegetable oils, and hydrolysed pea protein are commonly added to achieve the iconic chewable, foamy texture.
