- Children feel safe in school they know who to talk to if they are upset or struggling and feel that they are listened to when they do speak to an adult
- All classes like to the worry box as an option if they don't want to directly speak to an adult in the first instance
- In previous years, children in UKS2 have enjoyed being buddies at lunchtime for younger children e.g. encouraging play in FS, Wake Up Shake Up in KS1, buddies with equipment, Colouring Club in KS1 and KS2 playgrounds would like this/some other clubs to continue
- New equipment on playground is enjoyed and being well looked after older children would like to show/remind the younger children how to use and respect the equipment and how to put it away
- Children in KS1/that use the KS1 playground like to use the bench areas to sit and talk and know that if they are sat there alone, someone will come to help them – could be another child or an adult will check in
- KS2 playground benches aren't as welcoming and could perhaps be a focus area for outdoor improvements in the future
