- KS2 children enjoy tuck shop on a Friday pm and would like it to continue with healthy choices.
- Y6 pupils keen to lead/help to organise and suggest a new trolley that is easier to move around school – school fund, research ideas for Miss King and Mrs Hackfath
- Considered allergies – check with Miss King and have a range of options, including; rice cakes, Soreen bars, fruit (apple, raisins, cucumber, carrot sticks), fruit juice, yogurt tubes, ice-pops in warmer months, jugs of water (free), vegan, gluten and dairy free options
- Y6 pupils to work with staff to organise ordering new stock
- Revisit in a few weeks to gather information about snacks children enjoy and amend some choices if necessary – undertake market research

- Spooky music and popular songs to dance to
