Dear Parents/Carers,

Monday 20th November kick starts the Stanford Junior and Infant School Road Safety Week!

As part of our Road Safety Week we are encouraging walking, biking and scooting to school in a safe way. This includes wearing helmets, high visibility jackets and being aware of safe parking around our school. We will be rewarding children arriving safely to school with a 'Road Safety Card' that has been designed by our Year 6 Head Boy and Head Girl which will be awarded in the classroom. Each card will earn a tick on the class chart and work towards earning a Road Safety prize! This will also generate a class percentage and whole school percentage of children that have followed the safety advice shared in our Road Safety assembly and informative leaflet.

During the week we have workshops planned for Seedlings and Key Stage 1 led by Mr Cullam, Local Authority Road Safety Officer. Also, The Ryan Smith Foundation are leading an assembly on Tuesday morning to remind pupils about the importance of wearing a helmet when biking/scooting.

On Friday, 24th November 2017, we are organising a Coffee Afternoon to raise funds for our Road Safety Campaign. Any money raised will support the purchase of helmets etc. Please donate a cake/biscuits (nut free) and come along to join us from 2.00pm if you are available. Posters, leaflets and research created by the pupils will be on display. The school's Road Safety Committee will also be available to discuss the school's aims around this subject.

We will be continuing our Road Safety initiative in the Spring Term by having a Road Safety Week the first week of every month.

We look forward to having your support with this initiative and helping children in our community to arrive at school safely.
